They regulate and inspect care services to make sure they meet the right standards, everyone is entitled to safe, high quality, compassionate care that meets their needs. It is against the law for care services to operate unless they register with the Inspectorate. The Inspector will talk to people using the service, staff, and Managers and observe what happens in the service to help assess the quality-of-care people receive. Our inspector Lorraine Wright Came in for a couple of days to complete her inspection, she spoke to some of you and your family members to ask for feedback, we would like to thank everyone who spoke with her, she also spoke with all the staff looked at all our policies, procedures, and practices. Inspectors will look at the quality of: • care and support • environment • staffing • management and leadership and grade each area from 1(Unsatisfactory) to 6 (Excellent). We hope to receive our grade in the upcoming weeks, and we will keep you informed on the result. 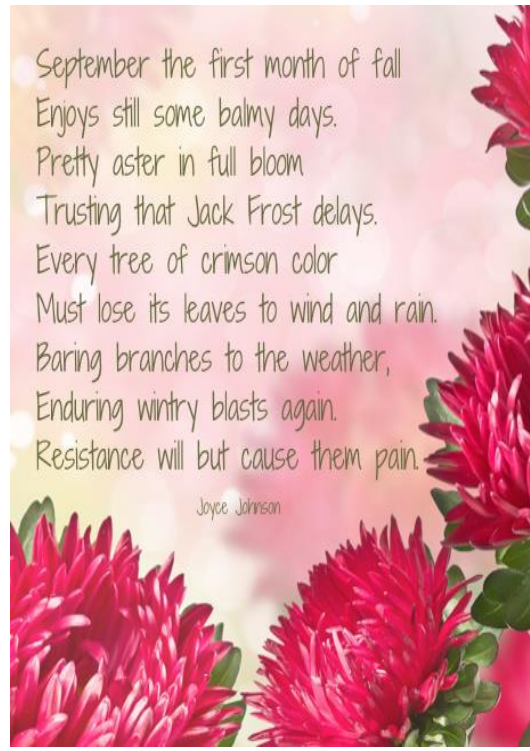
#### The Summer Event -Country and Western day
